PROJECT TITLE: Emergency Building Demolition

LOCATION: Old Sacramento State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Sacramento County

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: California State Parks proposes to demolish the building at 825 15th Street in Sacramento. The building is more than 50 years old but is not historically significant. The building roof sustained a major collapse during the winter storm event on March 9, 2023. Sacramento county was declared a disaster area due to this storm cycle so this project will be carried out under an emergency contract.

Project will:

- Remove and dispose of all debris inside building.
- Demo, remove and dispose of an approximately 13,000 SF structure and an attached concrete masonry (CMU) wall, down to slab. Slab and foundation to remain.
- Locate and cap existing lateral sewer line at the property lines and mark locations for potential future use.
- Flush cut all rebar and conduit at grade level and fill any open voids to with concrete slurry, to prevent tripping hazards.
- Leave slab empty and free of any debris upon completion of the project.
