Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project would restore the design flood conveyance capacity along an approximately nine-mile-long reach of Cache Creek by removing sediment along with vegetation and slightly raising levee elevations at selected locations. The proposed project would restore the original design flow and freeboard within the leveed area of Cache Creek. The schedule for the proposed project is anticipated to begin in 2026, at the earliest, and be completed in two years.

The Draft EIR analyzed the following environmental resources in detail: Aesthetics, Agriculture and Forestry, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology, Soils, and Paleontological Resources, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use and Planning, Noise, Recreation, and Transportation.
