Project Location (Riverside County): The TD1954721 Nighthawk Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located in Murrieta Creek approximately 500 feet southwest of the intersection of Hayes Avenue and Nighthawk Way, in the City of Murrieta, Riverside County, State of California; Latitude 33.56128, Longitude -117.23670; Assessor's Parcel No. 904-030-007.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-34090-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing one deteriorated wood pole (2090527E) with a new wood pole and caisson.

Project activities described above are anticipated to temporarily impact 0.007 acre (20 linear feet) and permanently impact 0.0002 acre (4 linear feet) within Fish and Game Code Section 1602 resources.
