**Project Title:** Hoekstra Coulter Lane Parcel Split (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. ELD- 37686-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Indian Creek, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Latitude 38.545262, Longitude -121.005121; 4200 Coulter Lane Shingle Springs, CA 95682; Assessor's Parcel Number: 087-030-036-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. ELD- 37686-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Trudy Hoekstra.

The project is limited to the widening of the existing road at Coulter Lane from 12 to 18 feet. The extension of Coulter Lane, terminating in a new cul-de-sac with driveway stubs serving the proposed subdivision. The road improvements and extension will require the installation of approximately 411 linear feet of new culverts, the replacement of 84 linear feet of existing culverts, rock slope protection on the inlets and outlets in five areas along Coulter Lane, and a 19-foot retaining wall. One common fig (*Ficus carica*) tree and one red willow (*Salix laevigata*) tree both less than 4 inches in diameter will be removed. One utility pole will also be relocated. All ground disturbing activities will be conducted when the tributary is dry.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The mitigated negative declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
