PROJECT LOCATION – COUNTY: The project site is located along North Piedra Road just north of east Princeton Avenue and north of the unincorporated community of Gravesboro, California. (158-080-28T) (3625 N Piedra Road) (Sup. Dist. 5).

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The County of Fresno's Department of Public Works and Planning (County) proposed to make park improvements. The Park is seasonally opened between the months of April to September. Current amenities within the Park include three picnic shelters, three public restrooms, picnic areas, tables, bbq pits, and other minor elements such as signage, lighting, and benches.

The County proposes to improve the existing amenities and create new opportunities for recreation at the Park with the following scope of work:

- Rehabilitate existing septic system
- Replace existing shelters with new premanufactured shelters that will have a shelter foundation of 2-3 feet deep and a new concrete pad poured underneath each of the new shelters,
- Install new prefabricated playground structures,
- Perform necessary improvements to parking stalls and public restrooms to make them ADA compliant,
- Build new or replace existing non-ADA asphalt concrete or concrete paths leading to new park improvements where the final layout of the path will be determined based on connectivity and the existing grade,
- Replace existing and/or install new picnic tables and barbeque grills,
- Install underground electrical conduits in 12 to 18 inch wide by 30-inch-deep trenches to provide power to new shelter and playground structures, and

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- Remove and/or trim trees as necessary to install new paths, play structures, and shelters.

Improvement of the project would allow compliance with the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA).

REASONS WHY THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The projects involves minor alteration to an existing facility, the installation of ADA compliant automatic opening doors, and the installation of a new small paved parking lot; adjacent to the facility site. The project will not affect any historic resources, the project site is not located in a flood hazard area, nor is the project site located on or near any known hazardous waste sites. Approval of this project will not result in any land use changes or an increase in density.

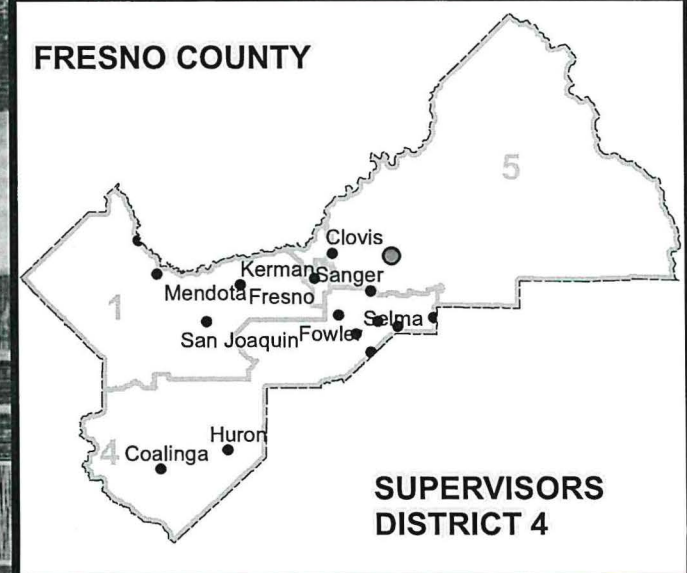
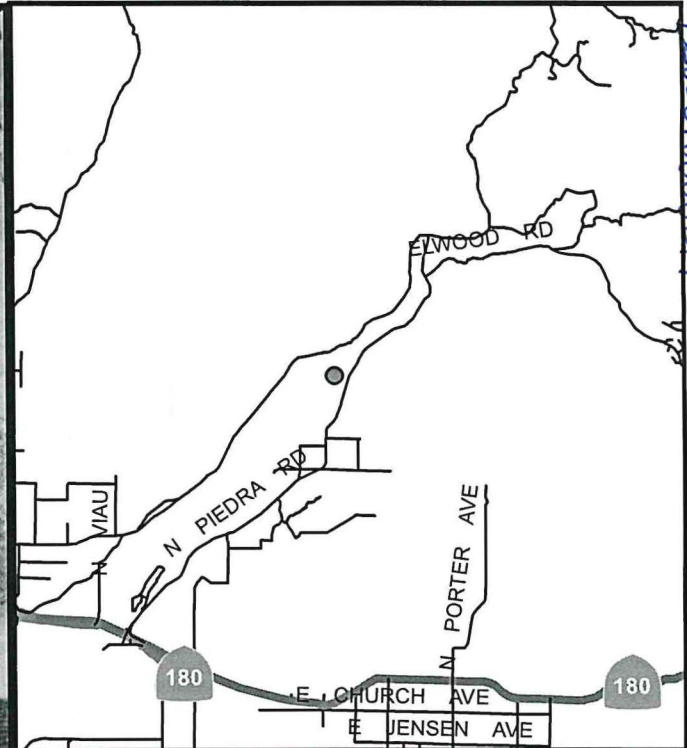
