Description Of Nature, Purpose, And Beneficiaries of the Project: CDCR Division of Adult Paroles, will lease an approximately 4,630 square foot office located in San Francisco, CA. The project will involve a total build out of a new office including offices, putting in testing restrooms, CAT 6 cabling, all new electrical fixtures, paint, carpeting, and roll up shades. The project will also include the installation of a security system, including exterior cameras, alarm keypads, and key card readers. This project is needed as the San Francisco Parole office must relocate and provide a clean and safe working environment for staff and parolees.

Reason Why Project Is Exempt: The project is categorically exempt from CEQA under the “Class 1” (14 CCR §15301) exemption per the CEQA Guidelines because the project involves negligible to no expansion of use. The project site is located within a previously disturbed area that is not considered environmentally or historically sensitive. This is one of a class of projects that the Secretary for Resources has found do not have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore is declared to be categorically exempt from the requirement for preparing an environmental document

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
