The proposed project is HM-1 Highway Maintenance pavement in Sacramento County on Route 12 that will perform digouts at various locations. Digouts will grind and replace existing Asphalt Concrete (AC) pavement either partial or full depth and excavate 6 inch typical depth of existing Aggregate Base material after the digout.

Purpose: The purpose of this project has been initiated to preserve the existing facility and prevent further deterioration of the roadway.

Need: As the pavement ages its condition will gradually deteriorate. The pavement condition report projects a maintenance project is warranted to increase the remaining service life of the existing pavement (See page 3).
