Description of Project:

Vertical Bridge is requesting permission to lease a portion of Sunrise Recreation and Park District property for a wireless telecommunication facility. This Notice of Exemption pertains only to the proposed lease consideration. Full approval and execution of the lease is subject to the project obtaining all necessary entitlements, including a project-level review by Planning and Environmental Review.

Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption (PRC Section 21084; CEQA Guidelines Sections 15300 -15333):

CEQA Guidelines Section 15305 – Minor Alterations to Land Use Limitations

Reasons why project is exempt:

Class 5 consists of minor alterations in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density.

Section 15300.2-Exceptions

Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines, Exceptions, provides conditions under which categorical exemptions are inapplicable. Review of the Project indicates that it will not violate any of the exceptions, as described in the following section.

- 1. The project will occur in certain specified sensitive environments or locations;
 - The Project site is fully developed within an urbanized community. The Project site has not been designated as a biologically sensitive location.
- 2. Cumulative impacts will be considerable because successive projects of the same type will occur at the same place overtime;
 - The Project will not be expected to result in significant cumulative environmental impacts. As it stands, the Project will not result in potentially significant impacts. Therefore, no cumulative impacts will result from the Project and successive projects of the same type and at the same place over time.
- 3. There is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances:
 - There are no known unusual circumstances that will have a significant effect on the environment.
- The project may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources within a highway officially designated as a scenic highway;
 - The Project is not located in the vicinity of a highway officially designated as a scenic highway. The closest state designated scenic highway is State Route 160, which is more than 12 miles to the southwest. Therefore, the project will not result in damage to scenic resources or similar resources within a highway that is officially designated as a scenic highway.
- 5. The project is located on a site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; or
 - The Project site is not included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code. Therefore, the Project will not have an impact related to being located on a hazardous waste site.
- 6. The project may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource.

The project site does not contain any historical resources.
