Title: Issuance of a General Lease – Public Agency Use – Lease 7632

Location: Sovereign land in Twelve Mile Slough, Ten Mile Slough, San Joaquin River, and the Stockton Deep Water Channel, Stockton, San Joaquin County.

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Public Agency Use to the Applicant beginning August 17, 2023, for a term of 20 years, for continued use of sewer pipelines in Twelve Mile Slough, Ten Mile Slough, San Joaquin River, and the Stockton Deep Water Channel, Stockton.


Categorical Exemption:

CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITIES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 2905, subd. (a)(2))

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 10-year General Lease – Public Agency Use for the above-mentioned structures will not cause a physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
