**Title:** Authorizing the removal and disposal of an abandoned vessel - Bosco Baby, USCG No. 653963

**Location:** Sovereign land in Mayberry Slough, near Donlon Island, Sacramento County.

**Description:** Authorize the Executive Officer, or her designee, to take title to the Bosco Baby, on or after September 18, 2023, unless before that date the vessel has been removed from state lands and not returned or has been moved to a permitted location, and; authorize the Executive Officer, or her designee, on or after September 18, 2023, to direct one of the Commission's on-call abandoned vessel services contractors to remove and dispose of the vessel.

CLASS 30, MINOR ACTIONS TO PREVENT, MINIMIZE, STABILIZE, MITIGATE OR ELIMATE THE RELEASE OR THREAT OF RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE OR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15330)

**Reasons for exemption:**

Removal of the above-mentioned structure will only cause a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemptions apply.
