Project Title: Beckstoffer Vineyards Eucalyptus Tree Removal (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-NAP-28246-R3)

Project Location (Napa): The Project is located at Conn Creek, in the County of Napa, State of California; Latitude 38.463446 °N, Longitude 122.391519 °W; 8550 Conn Creek Rd, Rutherford, CA, 94573; Assessor's Parcel Number 030-200-078.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-NAP-28246-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Beckstoffer Vineyards.

The Project is limited to the removal of up to 100 Eucalyptus (*Eucalyptus* sp.) trees along the upper bank of Conn Creek over a three-year period.


