Project Title: The Falls at Sanders Ranch Bank Stabilization Project (Notification of Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-CCA-29281-R3)

Project Location (Contra Costa County): The project is located on Rimer Creek in the Town of Moraga, Contra Costa County, California 94556; Latitude 37.82595 Longitude -122.10833; Assessor's Parcel Number 258-710-030-0.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-CCA-29281-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Common Interest Management Services, as represented by Michelle Kolodziej.

The project consists of the following: creation of two temporary access routes; removal of failed bank stabilization structures; grading, excavation and stabilization of two adjacent landslide areas within the creek channel and the remediation of the project area utilizing live plantings, seeding, mulching, and natural fiber products.
