DESCRRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to implement maintenance activities to repair a failed culvert located on Mt. Diablo Scenic Blvd in Mount Diablo State Park to ensure the safety of park visitors utilizing the road. Work will:

- Clear and grub work area to expose pipe,
- Excavate culvert inlet area and regrade existing drainage ditch,
- Connect 8-ft of new 15-in. perforated drainpipe and riser, and
- Import and place 3-in. or larger crushed rock.
