Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

DWR staff will break down, fill, and repair three areas of erosion along the primary and secondary sides of the Bank's Pumping Plant Intake Channel. The erosions will be broken down with a backhoe/excavator that contains a sheep's foot. Approximately 30 yards of native soil fill material and approximately 50 yards of ¾" road base will then be brought in by a loader and dump truck to backfill and compact the erosion locations. The banks will be reshaped as needed. Native soil is stored at the O&M Yard. All equipment and work are within the DWR right of way.
