PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An Administrative Use Permit application for the storage of agricultural equipment utilizing a 3-acre outdoor storage area surfaced in gravel. No structures are proposed with this application. No employees are proposed on-site. Access is proposed from North Tecklenburg Rd. The project site is not under a Williamson Act contract. (Use Type: Industry-Agricultural)

The Property is zoned AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/G (General Agriculture).
