The School District finds that this Ordinance is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) - common sense exemption, on the grounds that the standards contained therein are more stringent than those set forth in the State Energy Code and Green Building Standards Code, and as a result there are no reasonably foreseeable adverse impacts or possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment. The School District also finds that this project is exempt under Class 1 (Section 15301) because this project requires minor renovation of an existing parking lot which does not alter or remove any natural vegetation or trees and does not endanger any wildlife and the project is exempt from CEQA under class 8 section 15308, because it is a regulatory action for the protection of the environment.
