DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: Construct 4x20 ft pier from existing deck, 3x20 gangway, 10x20 ft floating dock, and 5x10 ft floating dock; repair approx 5x10 ft section of existing suspended platform that was damaged in Sulphur Fire. Project includes driving up to 5 new pilings. The project also includes placing metal stairs from existing deck to lakebed. Construction will occur within October 15 to December 31 work window. The project will further require a building permit from the Building Department.


REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:
