Project Title: Amendment #11 to Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2022-0001-R2, (SPI Caldor Fire Emergency Salvage Projects)

Project Location: The project is located in on an unnamed tributary to the Middle Fork of the Cosumnes River in El Dorado County; Latitude 38.578340, Longitude -120.534870; Township 8N, Range 13E, Section 3 of the Omo Ranch U.S. Geological Survey Quad Map, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Amendment #11 to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2022-0001-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Sierra Pacific Industries

The project is limited to the installation of a permanent 48-inch by 30-foot corrugated metal pipe (CMP) to allow for water to pass beneath existing seasonal road.


