The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Cannabis Distribution License submitted on 03/15/2019 by Adam Grossman.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of a cannabis business with manufacturing, retail, and distribution located at 4325 Broadway, Eureka, CA 95503. The APN is 302-171-039-000. It will operate out of an existing 55,552 SF building on a lot area of 7.98 acres. Nearby uses and scenery include service commercial, natural resources, public facilities, coastal agriculture.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is a Common Sense Exemption Project. Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), also known as the "general rule" exemption, CEQA exempts activities that can be seen with certainty to have no possibility for causing a significant effect on the environment. The Guidelines state in that section that "A project is exempt from CEQA if... The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA."
