Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project consists of the redesign and renovation of the existing 1.9-acre Weber Park located between Main Street and Circuit Drive within the City. The proposed project would include approximately 8 feet of excavation to grade the existing park to street level, removal of trees to improve park visibility, reconfiguration of the basketball court, expansion of the existing playground, addition of a new playground, removal of the bathroom, and the addition of a looped trail surrounding the multi-purpose turf field.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Nesting birds may be present if construction occurs during nesting season. Mitigation Measure BIO-1 requires nesting surveys by a qualified biologist.

Project would remove trees protected by local ordinance. Mitigation Measure BIO-2 requires compliance with the City's Tree Ordinance, including replacement, relocation, revegetation, and in lieu mitigation fees.

There are no known cultural resources, but excavation could uncover previously unknown resources. Mitigation Measures CUL-1 and CUL-2 provide process for discoveries of uncovered resources and human remains.

There are no known tribal resources, but excavation could uncover previously unknown resources. Mitigation Measure TCR-1, provided by United Auburn Indian Community, provides the tribe's recommended procedures for dealing with unanticipated discoveries.
