Project Title: Stream Crossing for Site Access (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SHA-40168-R1)

Project Location (Shasta): The project is located at Oak Run Creek, a tributary to Cow Creek, in an unincorporated area of Shasta County, California; Latitude 40.60662, Longitude - 122.15241, Section 25, Township 332N, Range 03W, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Palo Cedro U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor’s Parcel Number 060-640-050-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SHA-40168-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Beaver Association represented by Chuck Engell.

Work activities will include various projects to maintain an existing bridge crossing over Oak Run Creek at Beaver Road. The maintenance activities include painting girders, reinforcing rock that a pier rests on, replacing damaged wood members, clearing willows from the creek channel and at abutments of the bridge. Each maintenance activity will be small in scope and typically completed within a two-day period.
