PROJECT TITLE: Gilroy Yamato Hotsprings Fuel Reduction

**LOCATION:** Henry W. Coe State Park **COUNTY:** Santa Clara

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Conduct fuel reduction efforts within the Gilroy Yamato Hot Springs area of Henry W. Coe State Park to reduce the threat of damage from wildland fire and protect the hot springs' historic buildings and structures. Ongoing work will:

- Use hand and power tools to clear the road prism up to a height of 14 feet to create fuel breaks along all historic dirt roads within the site, allowing clearance for future grading;
- Use hand and power tools to thin vegetation under 6-in. diameter at breast height (DBH) and remove dead and downed fuels under 12 inch DBH;
- Remove and dispose of woody material using a chipper and/or pile burns with stacked burn piles no larger than 6 ft. x 6 ft. and processed chip piles no greater than 2 inches deep.
