Project Title: 1615 River Road Bridge Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-38371-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Truckee River, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 39.16507° North, Longitude 120.178406° West (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees), 1615 River Road, Tahoe City, CA 96145.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-38371-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Skywalker Investments, Inc as represented by Luke Emard.

The project consists of the removal of a failed vehicle bridge over the Truckee River, including the existing rock crib span supports and installation of a new free-span vehicle bridge within the same general footprint.

Person or Public Agency Carrying out Project: Skywalker Investments, Inc.

Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (2, 4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections (15302, 15304)

Reasons why project is exempt: Class 2 because the existing vehicle access bridge is being replaced by a new bridge constructed within nearly the same footprint as the existing structure that has failed. Class 4 because the replacement of the failing structure is a minor alteration to the land and does not involve the removal of any healthy, mature, scenic trees.
