Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the replacement of existing grass with decomposed granite for an existing open space amenity may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA review and none of the exceptions to the exemptions under CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply.
