The California Highway Patrol's Marin Area has reviewed the Environmental documents submitted by Caltrans District 4 for the State Route 131 Capital Preventive Maintenance Project (SCH #2023090705). The project will present transportation issues and effect traffic through the construction area. There is nothing in the project description that stands out though as impacting public safety, congestion, or traffic safety beyond what is expected for a project of this size. We anticipate there will be an impact to CHP operations with increased response times.
