**Project Location/City/County:** The project is located approx. 4,000 ft south of the west end of the Sacramento Bypass and adjacent to Tule Canal along on the right (east) bank in the Yolo Bypass in the City of West Sacramento, in Yolo County.

**Project Description:** Approval of Permit No. 19842, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To install a new 55.5 feet tall and 9.5 feet deep power pole. The project also includes approximately 58 feet of overhead connection 37 feet high.
