This project is a Site Approval application to establish 2 truck parking facilities for 120 trucks and 120 trailers. There are three existing buildings on site, a 95,040 square foot building, a 21,385 square foot building, and an 8,040 square foot building. Existing buildings will be used as ancillary storage to the truck parking operation. There are no proposed warehousing or storage uses for the existing buildings

Biological resources: The applicant has agreed to participate in the San Joaquin Multi-Species Habitat Conservation and Open Space Plan (SJMSCP). As a result, the proposed project is consistent with the SJMSCP, as reflected in the conditions of project approval for this proposal. Pursuant to the *Final EIR/EIS for San Joaquin County Multi-Species Habitat Conservation and Open Space Plan (SJMSCP)*, dated November 15, 2000, and certified by SJCOG on December 7, 2000, implementation of the SJMSCP is expected to reduce impacts to biological resources resulting from the proposed project to a level of less-than-significant
