
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SCR-43105-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Angela Bernheisel.

The project is limited to the bank stabilization on Soquel Creek, a Class I watercourse.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 7, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
