## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Project Name: Shasta County Wildfire Mitigation/Hazardous Fuels Reduction Project (Grant # 4382) SCH# 2023120609

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21000 et seg.) and Department procedures, notification is hereby given to responsible and trustee agencies, interest groups and the general public, that the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection proposes to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project described below.

## **Project Location:**

The project includes hazardous fuel reduction on private property within Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) areas in Shasta County.

## **Project Description:**

The proposed action consists of removing ground and ladder fuels up to 400 feet from each side of the PAA roadway centerlines, thinning trees to reduce crown closure, removing dead and dying trees within 100 to 200 feet of serviceable roadways or within landscape areas, and after removal activities, applying herbicide at regular intervals to control the future regrowth of unwanted vegetation and maintain an understory canopy without fire-prone fuels.
