Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located on Old River Rd at 38.619650, -121.563336, Reclamation District 537, crossing the right bank levee of the Sacramento River, in the city of Sacramento, in Yolo County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To authorize a 12-inch pipe through the levee above the 1957 water surface elevation of 34.4ft, waterside Corrugated Metal Pipe (CMP) standpipe with positive closure device and siphon breaker, pile mounted steel walkway, slant pump intake, return line and closure valve. The existing facilities are identified in the Supplement to U.S Army Corps of Engineers Standard Operations and Maintenance Manual for the Sacramento River Flood Control Project, Unit No. 116, at Levee Mile 2.84, within Reclamation District 537, and found in As-built drawings 06-13-0573 on Sheet No. 8.
