Project Title: Grasshopper Slough Levee Modifications Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YUB-39450-R2)

Project Location: 39.02730° N, -121.39143° W, along Grasshopper Slough's northern bank.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YUB-39450-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Reclamation District 2103 as represented by Dean Webb.

Reclamation District 2103 is proposing to improve a portion of the levee along Grasshopper Slough in Yuba County, California. The Project includes the repair of waterside streambank erosion, removal, and abandonment of decommissioned irrigation pipeline, filling a landside ditch, and resurfacing of the levee crown to meet FEMA standards.


Person or Public Agency Carrying out Project: Reclamation District 2103
