Project Location (include county): The Project to be completed is located within the Pilot Creek and Mad River watersheds, approximately 5.1 miles northeast of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 11 and 14, T2N, R5E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Blake Mountain U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 317-105-003; latitude 40.562 N and longitude 123.574 W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-HUM-35244-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Gyani Parminder.

The Project is limited to six (6) encroachments. Six encroachments are proposed to remediate streams altered by grading and to improve stream conveyance across roads on the parcel. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts or fill, stream remediation, compaction of unconsolidated fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
