The City of Jurupa Valley intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) for the Las Palmas residential subdivision project. The proposed project consists of the subdivision of 3.84 acres of land into thirty-six (36) lots for single-family detached homes. The proposed MND is supported by an Initial Study that evaluated potential effects with respect to Aesthetics, Agriculture, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, Energy, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use and Planning, Mineral Resources, Noise, Population and Housing, Public Services, Recreation, Transportation, Tribal Cultural Resources, Utilities and Service Systems, and Wildfire. The proposed MND determines that although the proposed Project could have a significant effect on the environment, there will not be a significant effect in this case because mitigation measures have been required or revisions in the Project have been made or agreed to by the Applicant. The City's decision to prepare an MND should not be construed as a recommendation of either approval or denial of this Project.

The City will receive written comments on the proposed MND beginning **October 13, 2023** through **November 1, 2023**.
