A Site Approval application for leisure vehicle storage to include a maximum of 12 storage spaces for boats and motor homes on a 0.66-acre parcel. The project includes the construction of a 216-square-foot office building, a 260-square-foot, 2-story caretaker residence, a 96-square-foot storage shed, a 144-square-foot RV shade structure, and grading for a total of 6 storage spaces. The storage facility will utilize an onsite well and septic system. A retention pond will be constructed for storm water drainage. The site is accessed from 1 driveway from the N. State Route 99 E.
