**Project Title:** First Major Amendment to Routine Maintenance Activities for Water Operation and Material Distribution Facilities (Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. 1600-2020-0206-R3)

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed a major amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. 1600-2020-0206-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the East Bay Municipal Utilities District, represented by David Carlson.

The major amendment consists of the delegation of the representative authority of the Permittee from David Briggs to David Carlson, the addition of protective measures for special status bumblebee and rodent species, and the inclusion of two new locations to the existing list of facilities where routine maintenance activities will occur:

- Danville Pumping Plant – 41 Scripps Haven Lane, Alamo 94507. Located on San Ramon Creek, tributary to Walnut Creek, tributary to San Pablo Bay, within the county of Contra Costa, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 188-241-006-09.

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- Redwood Reservoir – Adjacent to Terrabella Way, Oakland 94619. Center coordinate 37.796376, - 122.177903; Located on an unnamed tributary to Lion Creek, tributary to San Leandro Bay, within the county of Alameda, State of California; Assessor’s Parcel Number 37-2687-3.
