NOTICE OF DETERMINATION FOR THE 425 S. WINCHESTER BOULEVARD PROJECT (OLIN HOTEL PROJECT)

Project Description: The applicant proposes to amend The Santana Row/Valley Fair Urban Village (SRVF UV) Plan to amend the maximum building heights; amend the setback for new development when adjacent to residential and urban residential land use designations; amend the stepback (daylight) plane for new development when adjacent to residential and urban residential land use designations; and amend the no-setback and no-stepback plane required for new commercial development adjacent to sites with a Residential land use designation and an existing legally established commercial use to demolish an existing gas station and construct a new hotel on an approximately 0.55-gross-acre subject site.

The City has performed environmental review on this project.
