

Project Location: The Pipeline Maintenance Program encompasses all of Valley Water's raw, treated, and recycled water conveyance pipeline systems and related facilities and appurtenances in Santa Clara County and limited portions of San Benito and Merced counties.		
Project Description: The Pipeline Maintenance Program describes the inspection, maintenance, rehabilitation, and repair of over 150 miles of raw, treated, and recycled water conveyance pipelines, as well as associated infrastructure. This infrastructure comprises valves, vaults, storage tanks, pump stations, surge tanks, access roads, and related appurtenances.
