The purpose of the proposed project is to restore reliability and longevity to the Sacramento River Bridge Overhead. The southbound deck of the structure has elevated chlorides indicating active corrosion. The California Department of Transportation is proposing to replace the deck and railings on the Sacramento River Bridge Overhead.
