Tentative Parcel Map dividing an approximately 11.72-acre property into two parcels ranging between 5.02 acres to approximately 6.7 acres of total parcel area. The project site is located on north side of the intersection between Green Valley Road and Sierra Vista Road, in the Rescue Rural Center.
