PLN2023-0065 - CALOY COMPANY, LP** – Request to rezone 14.64± acres from Planned Development (P-D) (312) and General Agriculture (A-2-40) to a new P-D to allow for the expansion of an existing nut oil and cattle feed processing facility. The property is located at 5425 Montpelier Road, between E Keyes Road and E Monte Vista Avenue, in the Denair area.
