Project Title: Garvey Reservoir Rehabilitation Project

Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed Project is located at the Garvey Reservoir, an approximately 142-acre property at 1061 South Orange Avenue in Monterey Park, California. The proposed Project consists of rehabilitation/replacement of the reservoir cover and liner, inlet/outlet tower, junction structure, facility electrical system, standby generator, surge tank telemetry, and Administration Building and Water Quality Laboratory; construction of a new pump station; and miscellaneous site upgrades. Project construction activities would occur in three main phases. Both Phase 1 and Phase 2 would occur between approximately September 2025 and December 2027. Phase 3 would occur from approximately January 2034 to June 2035. Operations and maintenance activities at the Garvey Reservoir, including the frequency of staff visits, monthly testing of the standby generator, and water usage in the Administration Building and Water Quality Laboratory, would remain similar to existing conditions once construction activities are completed.

The Draft EIR includes an analysis of Project impacts to Air Quality, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Noise, Transportation, and Tribal Cultural Resources as well as feasible mitigation measures and a reasonable range of alternatives to avoid or reduce potentially significant impacts, if any. The Draft EIR identifies potentially significant impacts for air quality with a proposed mitigation measure for utilizing Tier 4 off-road construction equipment and certain electrically-powered construction equipment.
