Project Title: Cooks Culvert Replaced. 8165 San Gabriel Rd. Atascadero Ca. 93422 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SLO-35869-R4).

Project Location: The Project will occur within an unnamed tributary to Atascadero Creek at 8165 San Gabriel Road in the City of Atascadero, San Luis Obispo County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 054-151-056; Latitude 35.461137° North, Longitude -120.67064° West.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SLO-35869-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Roxie Schultzcooks.

The Project will correct a culverted driveway crossing. Activities include installing temporary erosion control measures; removing the driveway material, culvert rock headwalls, and existing culvert; installing utility sleeves under the crossing; realigning the replaced culvert and adding a second pipe to accommodate high flows; reconstructing the driveway and culvert headwalls; regrading and seeding slopes and disturbed areas; and removing erosion control measures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 3/5/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
