Description of Project: The City Parks Department will perform ongoing general maintenance and repair activities at City parks and facilities. As required to provide continuous service and protect the health and safety of the public, maintenance and repair activities will be conducted on City buildings, parks, structures, facilities, trails, mechanical equipment, fences, and property. Work will involve landscaping (spraying herbicide, spreading fertilizer, spreading wood chips and compost, mulching, blowing, hedging and pruning, weeding, mowing, clearing brush and branches, clearing fallen trees); painting; installing and repairing gates and fences; vegetation removal for public safety and security purposes; hydroseeding; trenching; watering; removing graffiti; maintaining and repairing facilities and irrigation systems; pressure washing; maintaining and repairing brush chippers, skid steers, mini excavators, front loader tractors, small engine equipment, and hand tools; washing equipment and vehicles; removing trash; maintaining sports fields; and maintaining City aquatic recreation features. All work will be conducted on City property.
