#### Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The purpose of the proposed project is to accommodate the anticipated increase in traffic volume to and from the new Bethel campus on Collyer Drive. Bethel Church plans to upgrade the intersection of Highway 299 and Old Oregon Trail to include realignment of two constructed ditches along Old Oregon Trail and College View Drive. Additionally, the current 28-inch by 20-inch arch culvert under College View Drive will be removed and a new 35-inch by 24-inch arch culvert will be installed connecting the two newly realigned constructed ditches. The culvert will be installed at the same inlet as the existing culvert and the new outlet will be located approximately 8 feet west of the existing outlet.

# **Exempt Status:**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15301, Existing Facilities.
