Project Location: The project is located at Grizzly Creek along State Route (SR) 20 in the County of
Lake (LAK), State of California. The post mile (PM) for this project is LAK-20 PM 39.37.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and
Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-43404-R2, pursuant to Section
1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The project includes the removal of approximately 2000 cubic yards of accumulated sediment and
vegetation as necessary from the rock-lined weir retention area within Grizzly Creek. The purpose of
this project is to maintain proper function of the weir. This maintenance activity will be performed
annually or biennially.
