The project involves the development of 18 three-story, 40-foot tall, multi-family residential buildings, totaling 87 condominium townhome units and associated private driveways on a 4.95-acre site. The condominium townhome units would range from 1,387 gross square feet (sf) and 1,837 gross sf (approximate). The project would have a total building area of approximately 141,887 sf. Additionally, the project would involve the construction of a 0.79-acre city park that would be accessed via Monterey Avenue. A portion of EI Monte Avenue would be converted to a pedestrian walkway that is referred to in the project plans as the EI Monte Paseo. The EI Monte Paseo, at 6,220-sf in area, would provide a pedestrian link from Valley Boulevard to the EI Monte Metrolink Station and EI Monte Trolley Station. APNs: 8575-017-909, 8575-019-907, 8575-019-908, 8575-019-910 through -914, 8575-021-932, 8575-021-936, 8575-022-922, and 8575-022-925.
