The project would: (1) install a hedgerow around the garden consisting of bee, bat and songbird boxes and approx 100 pollinator-attractive perennial plants; (2) establish two new planted areas (one area of pollinator seeding and one area of native perennial grass seeding) through light soil disturbance and broadcast seeding; (3) increase future grazable land area by cutting and chipping burned debris in an approx. 7-acre area, while also leaving some snags and some scattered brush piles with acorns planted underneath; (4) plant approx. 45 container perennials along a seasonal creek; (4) remove and replace approx. 1000 ft of hazard fence with wildlife friendly fencing; (5) build approx. 1300 feet of new wildlife-friendly fence. The objectives of the project are to 1) improve habitat for pollinators and other beneficial wildlife; (2) improve the farmers' grazable area and ability to manage their livestock movements while also allowing freer movement for wildlife; and 3) increase blue oak recruitment over the long term, consistent with ongoing grazing. Planting would occur in fall. Based on a reconnaissance-level survey, 2 sensitive species have the potential to be affected by the project (Monardella venosa and Sida/cea robusta), but landowners/implementers would receive education on identifying these species (which are conspicuous to a non-expert year round) so these rare plants, if present, would not be disturbed.
