**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: A Columbia State Historic Park concessionaire has requested to repair/replace the side porch, roof, and damaged gold panning troughs, at the Matelot Gulch Mining and Hidden Tours Treasure concession within Columbia State Historic Park to allow for continued use of the building, grounds and troughs for public education and enjoyment. Work will:

- Remove all rotted/old materials and debris from the building and grounds;
- Use in-kind materials to rebuild/repair the side porch and roof; and
- To repair/replace ten (10) gold panning troughs:
  - o Excavate one (1) 6-in. x 6-in. by up to 12 in. deep hole, per trough leg;
  - Set each new pressure treated leg into the hole, secure with cement and wrap each leg with 1 x 12-in. cedar planks;
  - o Install a black painted, galvanized sheet metal trough; and
  - o Install an upgraded trough water pump system.
