On November 18, 2023, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) published an Initial Study - Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS-MND) and the associated appendices for the State Route 29 Improvements at Rutherford Road and Oakville Cross Road Intersections (Project) on CEQAnet for public review.
