


Figure 1 - Location Map



Mitigation Measures included in the project to reduce potentially significant impacts to a less than significant level:

CR-MIT 1	Requires archaeological survey if artifacts are discovered. Avoidance of any nests discovered during western burrowing owl breeding season (February)
CR-MIT 2	Details required actions if historic or prehistoric resources are discovered.
HAZ-MIT 1	Requires government oversight of soil decontamination from the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health, the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board, or the California Department of Toxic Substances Control.
HAZ-MIT 2	Details dust management requirements.

A reporting or monitoring program must be adopted for measures to mitigate significant impacts at the time the Negative Declaration is approved, in accord with the requirements of section 21081.6 of the Public Resources Code.
